


Almost there!

Sixth Form Taster Days

On 6th and 7th July, over 100 of our prospective Sixth Form students attended two taster days, designed to give them an experience of 'A' level lessons. Students attended lessons in up to six different subjects and staff were given the remit to deliver a 'typical' 'A' level lesson for their subject. Students also had information sessions on other aspects of Sixth Form life such as the enrichment programme and Extended Project Qualification.

Mr Hardie spoke to the students at an opening assembly and his message was that the two days would "demonstrate the ability of our outstanding teachers to deliver 'A' level lessons to the same outstanding level they have established over many years at GCSE". The feedback on the taster lessons completed by students was exceptionally positive about the quality of teaching they experienced. Over 97% of students indicate they are 'Equally likely' or 'More likely' to come to Whitburn Sixth Form after taster days with over half indicating 'More likely'.

Late Applications

The near-completion of the building and word-of-mouth following taster days has led to a flurry of late applications. We are willing to accept late applications although priority will be given to students' who met February's deadline. There are places available in a number of subjects and we will have a clearer picture following August enrolment.
