Consent for Educational Visits taking place during the School Day

I would be grateful if you could sign and return the agreement form to help streamline the process of enabling students to take part in important events, visits and opportunities.

Please sign the form if you are happy for your son/daughter to:

- take part in trips and visits that take place off Academy premises without an overnight stay
- take part in sporting teams and events held at the Academy which are not part of the students normal study programme
- take part in off-site placements and visits as part of the Wednesday afternoon Enrichment programme, including optional sporting activities, some of which may run later than the end of the normal school day.
- make their own way to and from such visits and placements which may include (but is not limited to) placements at Primary schools, visits to local universities, visits to the public gallery at the law courts etc
- be given first aid or urgent medical treatment during any visit or activity.

Please note the following important information before signing this form:

The visits, activities and events covered by this consent include:

- all visits (not including residential trips) which take place during the normal school day.
- On or off-site sporting activities outside of and during the school day.

The Sixth Form will notify you of any visit or activity by letter (which may be sent by Secondary Contact) before it takes place. You can, if you wish, request that your son/daughter does not take part in a particular visit or activity.

By signing the Policy Agreement form you are agreeing that written parental consent will **not** be requested from you for the majority of individual off-site activities offered by the Sixth Form – for example placements and activities related to Enrichment or visits to local universities. This also applies to any sporting activities.

As part of this agreement, it is imperative that you give the Sixth Form all relevant details of any medical condition that your son/daughter suffers from and any medication your son/daughter should take during off-site visits.
