The overwhelming majority of students will study three A Level courses at Whitburn from September 2017, in common with the majority of Sixth Form providers nationwide. Universities tell us a fourth subject is no longer an advantage and they would rather see depth of knowledge. To this end, students may choose to complete an Extended Project Qualification (the 'EPQ') alongside their three A-Levels. They may also choose to study Core Maths to back up their studies in Science subjects.

In exceptional circumstances, students may be able to take four A-Levels, and this would normally be those students studying Further Maths. Please speak to the member of staff at your Guidance Meeting if you are interested in taking four A-Levels.
