INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES AND STAFF

Location: all examinations take place in the Sports Hall, unless shown otherwise on the timetable

Exam starting: 9:15 am or 1:30 pm prompt

Pre-revision: If applicable, subject teachers will organise pre-revisions sessions and inform candidates of time and venues

Y12 waiting to start the exam: please wait in the sixth form downstairs study area at either 9:05 am or 1:25 pm and wait to be escorted over

Access Arrangements: please make your way to the examinations with the rest of the pupils; you will be directed from there

Equipment: you must bring two black biro pens (a spare), a ruler, a calculator (unless told not to), pencils, a rubber, and a pencil sharpener to each exam. **Subject teachers will inform you of other equipment needed for your examinations**

Regulations: you must follow the regulations of the examination once you have entered the examination hall. The rubric (instructions/regulations) of the examination will be read out at the start of each set of exams. Failure to follow these instructions may lead to a disqualification. **Mobile phones and smart watches** must not be brought into the examination room; they should be in lockers, turned off. **Water bottles** and **pencil cases** must be see-through, with any labels removed. **All non -smart wrist watches must be placed on the desk in front of you. You must not have any writing on your hands, arms etc. Calculator lids must be removed and left in lockers.**
