1. Which Year Group are you in?



We will continue with setting work once per week and ensure all subjects move to doing this on a Monday


5. How easy have you found using Teams to receive and hand in work? 1 = very hard, 5 = very easy


Over 800 students have moved onto Teams for their education. This is really pleasing to see

8. Have your teachers been able to solve any issues you have with the work using Teams chat posts / etc?






The key themes coming from the longer answers are:

Theme	Our Response
Feedback	Departments have been asked to look at how feedback can be more specific and personalised in a manageable way
Organisation	From 1 st June all work will be set on Teams with only a brief overview for parents / carers put on the website. Hyperlinks will be used to resources in one drive / class materials
Timing of work	From 1 st June all work is on Teams on a Monday only each week.
Assignments	Teachers will make sure that turn in dates are flexible and to encourage hand in. Teachers have a schedule for assignment hand in which will spread the load for students
