Instructions for candidates

- **Location:** all examinations take place in the Sports Hall unless shown otherwise
- **Exam starting time:** Examinations start at 9:15 am, 11:30 am and 1:30 pm.
- **Waiting to start the exam:** Please line up in the yard, in the event of bad weather you will receive new instructions.
- **Bags:** you will be directed where to place your bags after you line up for the examination
- **Access arrangements:** please make your way to the examinations with the rest of the pupils; you will be directed from there to room 18.
- **Equipment:** you must bring two black biro pens (a spare), a ruler, a calculator (unless told not to), pencils, an eraser and a pencil sharpener to each exam. Subject teachers will inform you of additional equipment needed for your examinations.
- **Regulations:** you must follow the regulations of the examination (see page 2) once you have entered the examination hall. The rubric (instructions/regulations) of the exam will be read out at the start of each set of exams. Mobile phones must not be brought into the examination room; they should be in your bag, turned off. Water bottles and pencil cases must be see-through, with any labels removed. Smart watches are not allowed in the hall, and all non-smart wrist watches must be placed on the desk in front of you. You must not have any writing on your hands, arms etc. Calculator lids must be removed and left in your bag.

You will NOT be loaned any equipment in the examination hall other than a pen. This includes calculators.

Please read the JCQ information for candidates:

1. *Be on time for all your exams. If you are late, your work might not be accepted.*
2. *Do not become involved in any unfair or dishonest practice during the exam.*
3. *If you try to cheat, or break the rules in any way, you could be disqualified from all your subjects.*
4. *You must not take into the exam room: (a) notes; (b) potential technological/web enabled sources of information such as an iPod, a mobile phone, a MP3/4 player or similar device, a smartwatch or a wristwatch which has a data storage device. Any pencil cases taken into the exam room must be see-through. Remember: possession of unauthorised material is breaking the rules, even if you do not intend to use it, and you will be subject to penalty and possible disqualification.*
5. *If you wear a wristwatch the invigilator will ask you to remove it and place it on your desk.*
6. *Do not use correcting pens, fluid or tape, erasable pens, highlighters, or gel pens in your answers.*
7. *Do not talk to or try to communicate with or disturb other candidates once the exam has started.*
8. *You must not write inappropriate, obscene, or offensive material.*
9. *If you leave the exam room unaccompanied by an invigilator before the exam has finished, you will not be allowed to return.*
10. *Do not borrow anything from another candidate during the exam.*
