

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

- **Location:** all examinations take place in the Sports Hall
- **Exam starting time:** examinations start at 9:15 am and 1:20 pm
- **Waiting to start the exam:** please line up in the yard by form class, in the event of severe weather you will receive new instructions
- **Bags** should be brought to the sports hall and placed in the labelled area **by forename**
- **Equipment:** you must bring two black biro pens (a spare), a ruler, a calculator (unless told not to), pencils, an eraser, and a pencil sharpener to each exam. Subject teachers will inform you of additional equipment needed for your examinations
- **Regulations:** you must follow the regulations of the examination once you have entered the examination hall; failure to do so could lead to a malpractice. The rubric (instructions/regulations) of the exam will be read out at the start of each exam
- You must ensure the following:
 - **Mobile phones must be turned off**, they must be in your bags
 - Pencil cases must be see-through
 - Water bottles must be of the disposable type, see through and with the labels removed
 - **No watches are allowed at your desks**, they must be in your bags
 - You must not have any writing on you or with you including your hands, arms etc.
 - Calculator lids must be removed and left in your bags
- **You will NOT be loaned any equipment in the examination hall** other than a pen. This includes calculators. It is the candidate's responsibility to have the correct equipment for their examination.
