Instructions for Candidates

- Location: all examinations take place in the Sports Hall unless shown otherwise on the timetable
- Exam starting time: examinations start at 9:00 am or 1:20 pm
- Y13 waiting to start the exam: please wait in the sixth form, a member of the Sixth Form Team will tell you when to go to the venue. Bags, coats, phones and watches should be placed in lockers
- Access arrangements: please make your way to the examination with the rest of the pupils where you will be directed to your venue
- Equipment: you must bring two black biro pens (a spare), a ruler, a calculator (unless told not to), pencils, an eraser, and a pencil sharpener to each exam. Subject teachers will inform you of additional equipment needed for your examinations
- Regulations: you must follow the regulations of the examination once you have entered the examination hall; failure to do so could lead to a malpractice. The rubric (instructions/regulations) of the exam will be read out at the start of each set of exams:
- You must ensure the following:
 - Mobile phones must be in your lockers/bags
 - Pencil cases must be see-through
 - Water bottles must be of the disposable type, see through and with the labels removed
 - No watches are allowed at your desks, they must be in your locker/bags
 - You must not have any writing on your hands, arms etc.
 - Calculator lids must be removed and left in your locker/bags

You will NOT be loaned any equipment in the examination hall other than a pen. This includes calculators.

JCQ rules state that it is the candidate's responsibility to have the correct equipment for their examination.
