

Results Day – Collection of Results 2026

Results can be collected in person as follows:

Thursday 13 th August 08.00am – Sixth Form	A Level, AS Level, Extended Project Qualification (EPQ), Level 3 Core Maths and BTEC Health and Social Care
Thursday 20 th August 08.00am – Septimus Hall	GCSE, Level 1 and Level 2 Vocational and Technical Qualifications, Cambridge Nationals

Examination results will be available for collection by students **from 8am**. Results can also be collected from the Main Academy Office from **11:00 to 15:00** on the respective Results Days. Staff will also be in the academy to give advice to students in the light of their results.

If your child cannot collect their results in person, we can post their results through their **school ‘Teams Chat’** account. If your child would like this service, they can request via email to:

Please note: Examination results shared via **school ‘teams chat’** will be sent later in the morning, once the ‘in person’ collections have finished. **Please note examination results cannot be sent to any other email addresses or shared over the phone.**

Examination results collected by another person **must be accompanied by a signed letter from the student**, and the person collecting the results must bring photographic identification e.g. passport or driving license, to confirm their **own** identity for verification purposes.
